DISHONEST, DECEPTIVE OR MISLEADING CONDUCT OFFENCE LOTTERY AND GAMING ACT 1936

The Authorised Betting Operations Act 2000, which was assented to by the Governor on 21 December 2000, introduced a new regulatory regime for totalisator and betting operations and made consequential and administrative amendments to the Lottery and Gaming Act 1936 ("the Act"). These amendments to the Act became effective from 14 December 2001.

Of particular significance to the administration of lotteries is the introduction of a new offence under the Act. The offence provision, designed to ensure that agents or others who act dishonestly in the course of conducting a lottery are subject to a criminal penalty, reads:

"Dishonest, deceptive or misleading conduct

113A. A person involved (whether as principal, agent or employee) in the conduct of any lawful or unlawful lottery, gaming or betting operations who acts in a dishonest, deceptive or misleading manner in connection with the operations is guilty of an offence.

Maximum penalty: \$50 000 or 2 years imprisonment."

In addition, the maximum fines for offences against the Act have been increased.

A new evidentiary provision has replaced the former section 98 of the Act. The provision reads:

"Evidentiary provision relating to licences and permits

- 98. In proceedings for an offence against this Act, an allegation in the complaint –
- (a) that a person was or was not at a specified time the holder of a specified licence or permit under another Act; or

(b) that a specified licence or permit under another Act was at a specified time subject to specified conditions,

will be accepted as proved in the absence of proof to the contrary."
