CHANGE OF NAME FOR OFFICE

From 21 September 1998 the State Taxation Office will be known as RevenueSA.

The primary motivation for the change of name was to avoid the ongoing confusion between this Office and the Australian Taxation Office. The taxpayer and general community have traditionally confused the two offices and all other States have dropped the reference to taxation in an attempt to address this issue.

The name also now more properly reflects the changing value of the work of the Office.

The Commissioner will continue to be the Commissioner of State Taxation, as has been the case since 1 July 1997 through the *Taxation Administration Act 1996* with the cessation of the use of the title Commissioner of Stamps and Commissioner of Land Tax.

Telephone and facsimile numbers remain unchanged as do e-mail and postal addresses. The Office continues to be located in the State Administration Centre and continues to be a division of the Department of Treasury & Finance.

The new name will be phased in gradually as old stocks of stationery etc are exhausted.
