**SOUTH AUSTRALIAN LOTTERY & GAMING REGULATIONS 1993
CHANGES TO APPLY FROM 6 APRIL 1999**

New regulations governing the conduct of Trade Promotion Lotteries have been introduced and took effect from 6 April 1999.

The conditions that apply for Trade Promotion Lotteries are outlined in a Schedule available from this Office. Many of the conditions are the same as those currently in place. However, some important variations to the conditions affecting Trade Promotion Lotteries apply, as follows.

1. An application for a Trade Promotion Lottery Licence must be accompanied by a licence fee calculated on the basis of the total value of all the prizes in the lottery, as follows:

| (ii) | for a total value of more than \$10,000 but not more than \$50,000 | \$ | 250 |
| (iii) | for a total value of more than \$50,000 but not more than \$100,000 | \$ | 500 |
| (iv) | for a total value of more than \$100,000..... | \$ | 1,000 |

However, if the terms of the lottery provide for the allocation of prizes among a number of States or Territories, then the licence fee is to be calculated on the basis of the total value of only those prizes to be allocated to winners in this State.

2. If a licensee applies for variation of the terms of the lottery, the application must be accompanied by a fee of \$30.
3. Applications must be lodged not earlier than 4 months before the proposed date of commencement of the lottery.
4. All fees paid are non-refundable.

Copies of the new Application form, Trade Promotion Conditions and an Application to Amend a Trade Promotion form can be obtained from this Office.

Delays in processing applications and amendments may be experienced if incomplete or incorrect forms or fees are submitted to this Office.
