

Stamp Duties Act 1923

Schedule 2, Part 2, General Exemption 23(1)

Application for Exemption for service/ex-service persons

Use this application to claim an exemption of up to \$132 of the stamp duty payable on the purchase of a place of residence. If you have paid stamp duty, you may use this form to claim a refund of up to \$132.

An exemption may be available where the applicant:

- was on active service, or in a naval, military or air force operation, in one or more of the following proclaimed areas:
 - World War II (between 3 September 1939 and 31 December 1945);
 - Korea (between 25 June 1950 and 25 November 1960);
 - Malaya (between June 1948 and November 1960);
 - Malaysia (between 16 September 1963 and 30 September 1967); or
 - Vietnam (between 31 July 1962 and 23 December 1973); or
- is the widow or widower of a person who was on active service, or in a naval, military or airforce operation in one of the above proclaimed areas; and
- will, or intends to, reside in a house on the land that has been purchased; and
- has not already received an exemption under this provision.

Evidence of service must be provided. Evidence may include:

- Discharge certificate;
- Pay book; or
- any other evidence of service.

PLEASE NOTE: If you did not serve in one of the proclaimed areas, but are a recipient (or the widow or widower of a recipient) of the Australian Active Service Medal 1945 to 1975 and/or the Australian Active Service Medal for service you may be eligible for *ex gratia* relief. Please complete an *Application for Ex-gratia Relief for service/ex-service persons*.
