**SOUTH AUSTRALIAN LOTTERY & GAMING REGULATIONS 1993  
TRADE PROMOTION LOTTERY  
CHANGES TO APPLY FROM 17 AUGUST 2000**

The *Lottery and Gaming Regulations 1993*, at Regulation 24A details the rules that apply as a condition of trade promotion lottery licences.

It is a rule applying to trade promotion lotteries that entry must be free, except that the costs of entry by telephone or post may be payable by participants. Effective from 17 August 2000 the maximum cost of entering the lottery by telephone has been increased to take into account the impact of the GST on telephone call costs.

Regulation 24A (1) (a) as varied, allows a trade promotion lottery telephone entry, to cost a lottery participant a maximum of 50 cents, after deduction of the GST payable in respect of the call.
